Dear Parent or Guardian,

Polk County Public Health will provide childhood vaccinations to children at school locations throughout Burnett County. The vaccines will be provided at **no cost** to children who **qualify** under the Vaccines for Children (VFC) program. Any person who is 18 years of age or younger and meets at least one of the following criteria is eligible to receive vaccines:

- **Child is eligible for or enrolled in Medicaid/BadgerCare**
- **Child does not have health insurance**
- **Child has health insurance that does not cover vaccinations**
- **Child is American Indian or Alaskan Native**

 All clinics will be held for 2 hours during school conference hours.
