- Feedback and grading are timely and specific

#### High Expectations/High Support

- Provide a course syllabus that helps parents and students understand expectations
- Provide appropriate accommodations
- Students should be engaged
- Students should feel supported and know they are cared about
- Post clear classroom rules and/or respect agreements
- Facilitate parent engagement and communication

#### Learning Environment

- Promote student voice and choice
- Create a classroom environment in which students feel safe and comfortable
- Listen to students' concerns and feedback
- Plan a strong introduction and closure for each lesson
- Encourage enjoyment of learning
- Establish a positive, student-centered environment
- Facilitate active engagement

#### Professionalism

- Gather feedback via teacher assessments through
  - Self-assessments high expectations for teachers themselves
    - Self-reflections
    - Teacher surveys (by students)
    - Principal feedback
- Collaboration
  - Share best practices
  - Attend conferences and trainings
  - Maintain open-mindedness about changing classroom practices
- Use allotted planning time effectively
- Demonstrate a passion for your content area and teaching
